**ESTABLISHING BALIWAG BARANGAY "BIDA"  
(Best Initiatives/ Initiators for Development Awards)**

**WHEREAS**, the Municipality of Baliwag is striving to yield gradual evolution perceptible in its activities, operations, and creations.

**WHEREAS**, there is a need to establish a municipal system of awards as a specific strategy to promote quality excellence in barangay units, and provide a framework for assessing organizational performance and recognizing quality excellence;

**WHEREAS**, based on the above premises, the Municipality of Baliwag is bent to recognize and reward high performing Barangay and its officials, towards realizing its vision of pro-active governance.

**NOW, THEREFORE, I, FERDINAND V. ESTRELLA**, Municipal Mayor of Baliwag, Bulacan, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby order:

**SECTION 1. CREATION OF THE AWARD-** The Barangay "BIDA" (Best Initiatives/Initiators for Development Awards) is hereby instituted as Municipality's Award to recognize outstanding contributions of barangays, its officials and volunteer workers.

**SECTION 2. OBJECTIVES OF THE AWARD** – The Barangay "BIDA" aims :

- A. To honor and recognize the best practices in the barangays, and the individuals who stepped up to exemplify the best qualities and outstanding performance of being a barangay official or volunteer.
- B. To inspire and encourage Baliwagenyos to excel in their craft and contribute significantly, thus making a difference in the lives of the many.
- C. To compile a story of achievers who will automatically represent Baliwag in other award giving bodies with the same set of qualifications.

- D. To propagate the best practices and replicate it in many barangays in Baliwag.
- E. To promote a culture of excellence in local governance.

**SECTION 3. CATEGORIES-** The categories for the Baliwag Barangay BIDA are the following:

- A. Barangay programs based on the criteria of the seal of good local governance and
- B. Barangay officials and volunteers:

**SECTION 4. QUALIFICATIONS-** This award shall be open to all barangays in Baliwag, its officials and volunteers, with eligible programs, projects, accomplishments, that will suit the requirements of the award categories.

For the program to be considered in Baliwag Barangay BIDA, Baliwag will adopt the following minimum requirements from Galing Pook Awards:

- It must have involved or engaged processes within a local government unit even if the program might have been initiated (either independently or jointly) by an NGO, CSO and/or an LGU.


- It must have been in operation for at least one (1) year before the deadline of submission.
- It must have verifiable and significant results.

For the individual awardee, he or she must be in barangay service for at least one year before the deadline of submission.

**SECTION 5. ORGANIZATION OF A TECHNICAL WORKING GROUP-** The Municipal Mayor shall organize the Technical Working Group to serve as the implementing arm as well as administrative secretariat of the Committee.

**SECTION 6. EFFECTIVITY-** This Executive Order shall take effect immediately.
