EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 004 S. 2018

EXECUTION OF MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE NO. 4 S. 1995 AND PROHIBITION OF
JUNK SHOPS OR ANY JUNK RECOVERY ESTABLISHMENTS TO OPERATE ALONG
IRRIGATION CANALS IN BALIWAG

WHEREAS, Section 48 of Republic Act 9003 also known as Ecological Solid Waste Management of 2000 prohibits the littering, throwing, dumping of waste matters in public places, such as roads, sidewalks, canals, esteros or parks, and establishments and the open burning of solid wastes;

WHEREAS, Section 10 of Republic Act 9003 also provides that it is the role of the Local Government Units to implement and enforce its provisions;

WHEREAS, Municipal Ordinance No. 4 S. 1995 entitled as the "*Kautusang Bayan na Nagbabawal sa Sinumang Tao na Magtapon ng Basura sa mga Kanal na nasa Harap ng Bawat Bahay, mga Bangketa at Kalsada, Maging Ito ay Pambarangay, Pambayan at Pambansa at mga Bakanteng Lote na Pag-aari ng Pribadong Tao at sa Gilid o Pampang o Patubigan o Kanal na Daluyan ng Tubig*" was created to prevent litters from being carried or deposited by the elements upon any public place or private premises;

WHEREAS, junk recovery establishments along irrigation canals are contributors of waste in water ways in Baliwag;

WHEREAS, waste dumping, results in heavy siltation, clogs waterways and reduces the irrigation capacity of the canal systems from the main canals, lateral canals, sub-lateral canals, sub-lateral canals and farm ditches;

WHEREAS, junk recovery establishments burn waste to collect metal residues from scrap materials;

WHEREAS, junk recovery establishments along irrigation canals have no necessary permits to continue their business;

NOW THEREFORE, I FERDINAND V. ESTRELLA, Municipal Mayor of the Municipality of Baliwag, Bulacan, by virtue of the powers vested in me by law, do hereby order;

SECTION 1. PROHIBITION.

- A. No person whether natural or juridical shall operate a junk recovery establishment along any part of irrigation canals in the vicinity of Baliwag.
- B. No person whether natural or juridical shall dispose their garbage/waste (fly tipping) on sidewalks and roads whether public or private and vacant lots.
- C. It is strictly prohibited to dump wastes on canals and irrigations.

SECTION 2. CRIMINAL OFFENSES AND PENALTIES

- a.) The penalty of permanent closure of establishment shall be imposed upon any person who shall violate Section 1(A) of this Order.
- b.) Any person who violates section 1 (B) and (C) shall, upon conviction, be punished with a fine of *two thousand pesos (P2000)* or *one (1) month imprisonment* or both. (*Penalties under Section 2 of Municipal Ordinance No. 4 s. 1995*)

SECTION 3. ENFORCEMENT.

The Municipal Environment and Natural Resources Office (MENRO) , Philippine National Police (PNP) and the Barangay Captains shall enforce compliance with this Executive Order. The MENRO may deputize the ECO-POLICE for enforcement purpose while the Barangay Captains may assign their Barangay Police Officers to implement the provisions of this order.

The MENRO, Barangay Captains and the PNP shall have the power to inspect and endorse violating establishments to the Municipal Mayor for appropriate action.

SECTION 4. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE

If any provision or part thereof is held invalid or unconstitutional, the remainder of the law or the provision not otherwise affected shall remain valid and subsisting.


SECTION 5. REPEALING CLAUSE

All executive orders, rule and regulations that are inconsistent herewith shall be deemed revoked, amended and/or repealed accordingly.

SECTION 6. EFFECTIVITY.

This order shall take effect immediately.
