CREATION OF LOCAL COMMITTEE ON ANTI-TRAFFICKING AND VIOLENCE AGAINST WOMEN AND THEIR CHILDREN (LCAT-VAWC)

WHEREAS, Republic Act No. 9208 or the “Anti-Trafficking in Persons Act of 2003” declares that the State shall give highest priority to the enactment of measures and development of programs that will promote human dignity, protect the people from violence and exploitation, eliminate trafficking in persons, and mitigate pressures for involuntary migration and servitude of persons to ensure their recovery, rehabilitation, and reintegration.

WHEREAS, Republic Act No. 9262 or “Anti-Violence against Women and their Children Act” underscores the commitment of the State of safeguarding the dignity of women and children while guaranteeing full respect of their human rights and to protect them from violence and threats to their personal safety and security;

WHEREAS, These two laws likewise provide stronger mandates and direction to relevant government agencies and stakeholders to immediately address human trafficking and VAWC by organizing Inter-Agency Councils (IACs) for trafficking (Section 20 of RA 9208) and VAWC (Section 39 of RA 9262);

WHEREAS, Cognizant of the important roles and responsibilities of field offices of National Government Agencies (NGAs) and Local Government Units (LGUs) in the effective implementation of these laws, and in the prevention and monitoring of trafficking and VAWC cases at the local level, Section 13 of the IRR of RA 9208 and Section 59 of the IRR of RA 9262 further encourage the National IACs to establish or create mechanisms that shall facilitate the implementation of these laws at the local levels;
